Liability Waiver & Emergency Contact Information

I am aware that riding horses and being in the presence of horses and donkeys poses certain risks of injury. I am aware that equestrian activities can be dangerous and physical injury and death can occur. I am aware that horses, as animals, can be unpredictable and that control cannot always be maintained. I am aware that Lucky Clover Rescue has no history on its rescue horses at the time of intake.

I, and my heirs, executors and administrators, will not hold Lucky Clover Rescue, its Board members, representatives, volunteers and agents thereof responsible for, and waive any and all claims I may have against any or all of them if, injury, damage or death were to occur to myself, my property or anyone in my care while participating in any activity with or for Lucky Clover Rescue at any location.

I agree to hold harmless and indemnify Lucky Clover Rescue, its Board members, property owners, representatives, volunteers and agents from any and all liability for any damage to property or personal injury, damage or death to any third party resulting from my use of the facilities, horses, services or presence on any property or venue provided by or supporting Lucky Clover Rescue activities, exhibits or events. I agree to hold harmless and indemnify Lucky Clover Rescue, its Board members, representatives, volunteers and agents from any and all liability for any damage to property or personal injury, damage or death to any minor(s) in my care, for which I may or may not be a parent/guardian, from their use of the facilities, horses, services or presence at any property or venue provided by or supporting Lucky Clover Rescue activities, exhibits or events.

Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities. Each participant, or parent or guardian of a minor participant may execute a release assuming the risks of engaging in equine activities. The release shall give notice to the participant or parent or guardian, of the risks of engaging in equine activities, including (i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to the participant, (ii) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movement, objects, persons or animals, and (iii) the hazards of surface or subsurface conditions. A release shall remain valid until expressly revoked by the participant or is a minor, the parent or guardian.
